This expansion adds to Kosmo's growing inventory of high-performance, high-tolerance production machinery.

With a maximum work piece size of 16.6" in diameter x 60" long the two Mazak Quick Turn lathes add to existing mid-size part capacity while increasing current



multi-tasking capabilities and new project availability. The turning centers include 12-tool turrets and four feed axes; advanced software permits conversational programming (without external CAD/CAM software).

The Fanuc RoboCut C400ic is equipped with a digital power supply, second generation artificial intelligence (Ai2), and rotary glass encoders guaranteeing .000002” repeatability; positioning the machine at the forefront of EDM technology.

“Rounding out our EDM department, this will be Kosmo’s 5th wire EDM and will support three die sinking machines and a small hole EDM”, said Heath Stewart,



VP of Operations. Adding, “electric discharge machining is one of the fastest developing forms of subtractive manufacturing, due in part to evolving artificial intelligence and newly enhanced positioning accuracies which allow EDM’s the ability to machine, stress free, virtually any conductive material regardless of

Rockwell hardness.”
